### **2011 Carnevale Cabernet Franc**      Glass 7    Bottle 14.99

Carnevale was named after one of Antonio Brunicardi's vineyards in Bagni di Lucca Italy. This easy-drinking red is the product of hand harvested Cabernet Franc and fermented using traditional Burgundian open top/punch down techniques. Barrel aged 26 months in French/American oak barrels. Bottled with minimal intervention, or manipulation to capture the "somewhereness" of La Vigna

### **2010 La Vigna Cabernet Blend (PRW)**      Glass 8    Bottle 19.99

The declaration of Proprietary Red signals a wine crafted exclusively from Bordeaux grape varieties and is considered the very best of La Vigna. Elegant and refined, this beautiful vintage unfolds on the palate in incremental layers of flavors. Aged 26 months in American/French Oak barrels. Bottled with minimal intervention, or manipulation to capture the "somewhereness" of La Vigna.

**2008 La Vigna (PRW) Red "HardTop"**      Glass 14    Bottle 36.99 A reserve barrel offering of our Cabernet Franc/Cabernet Sauvignon Blend selected by majority vote by over 300 barrel-tasters during the 2010 Harvest Celebration. Vivid, intense aromas of new saddle leather, huge extractions of black currant, sweet tannin, and a multilayered finish that seems to never end. Bottled unfiltered with minimal intervention, or manipulation to capture the somewhereness of La Vigna.

## White and Rose Wine

**2012 Carnevale Rosato di Cab Franc**      Glass 7    Bottle 16.99 This crisp, light-bodied rosato is the perfect wine for sipping on a hot summer day. Dry, fruity and slightly salmon hued, this wine is the product of hand harvested The crisp, cool flavors of a well-balanced rosato pair well with grilled, steamed or poached fish, lobster, and risotto.

**2013 Carnevale Petit Manseng**      Glass 7    Bottle 14.99 This version shows the yeast-lees influence and vanilla character of barrel fermentation. With full, unforgettable aromas of honey, tropical and stone fruit flavors. The result is a rich, oak-influenced white with a flavor all its own. Bottled with minimal intervention, or manipulation to capture the "somewhereness" of La Vigna.

**2013 La Vigna (PWW) Petit Manseng**      Glass 8    Bottle 19.99 The ultra-premium white varietal of southwest France. A rich, exotic dry white with aromas of white flowers and herbal notes. On the palate, flavors of citrus, almonds, and apricots, with a long bracing finish. Bottled with minimal intervention, or manipulation to capture the "somewhereness" of La Vigna.

**2010 La Vigna (PWW) "Late Harvest"**      Glass 9    Bottle 14.99 Cuttings taken from centuries old vines grown in the Jurancon region of southwest France, at the foot of the Pyrenees, it makes what Jancis Robinson eloquently describes as "one of France's unusually underrated treasures, Jncon Moelleux, a seductively juicy, sweet, long-lived white."
